REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATIONS 2021

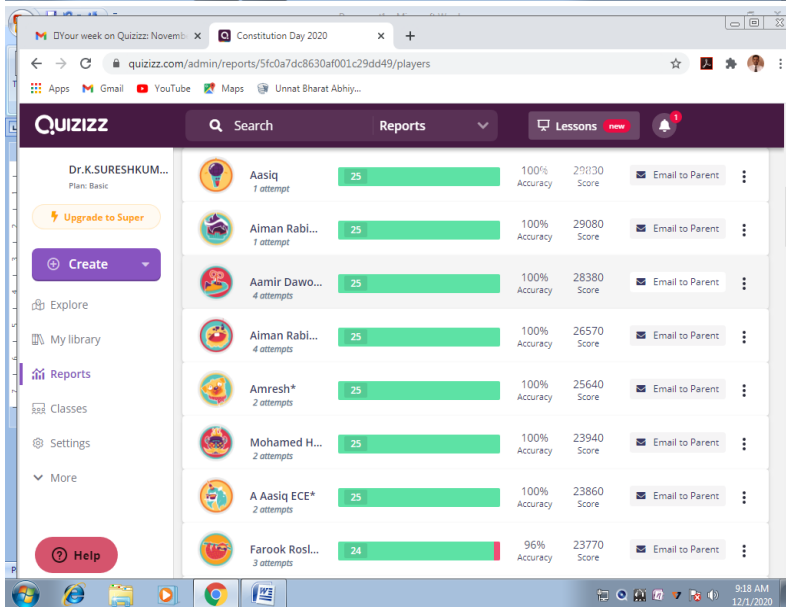
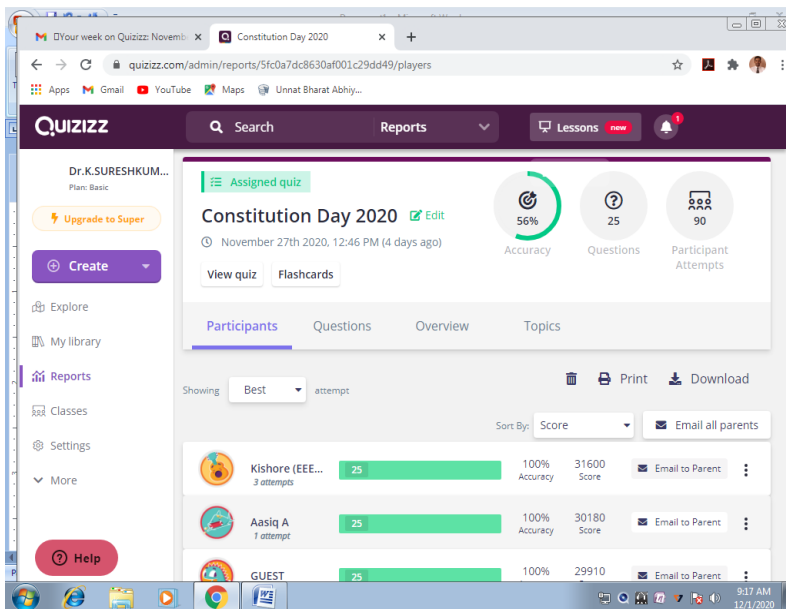


