MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is executed on this the 6th of October 2017, at Chennai:

BY AND BETWEEN

MICHELIN INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED, a company incorporated and registered under Companies Act, 1956 having its registered office at Shyamala Towers, 3rd Floor, 136 Arcot Road, Saligramam, Chennai - 600 009 and factory at A-1 SIPCOT Industrial Complex, Thervoykandigai, Thiruvallur District, Tamil Nadu, India 601 202 (hereinafter referred to as "MIPL" which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, mean and include its successors-in-interest and permitted assigns), of the ONE PART;

AND

AALIM MUHAMMED SALEGH TRUST a society/trust duly registered under the laws of India, having its place of business at "Nizara Bonanza", 813, Anna Salai (Opp.LIC), Chennai 600002 and which runs Aalim Muhammed Salegh College Of Engineering represented by Mr. Segu Jamaludeen (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party" which expression, unless repugnant to the context, shall mean and include its authorized and legal representatives, employees, successors-in-interest and permitted assigns) of the OTHER PART.

MIPL and the Second Party are hereinafter referred to individually as "Party" and collectively as "Parties" unless the context requires otherwise.

WHEREAS:

MIPL is engaged in the business of manufacturing tyres and has its manufacturing facility in the State of Tamil Nadu, India. MIPL intends to provide training in certain technical areas including engineering and technology;

Second Party is pioneer in the field of imparting education in India and provides education in the field of engineering and technology;

Second Party is interested in obtaining specialized training from MIPL to its students who are willing to undergo training;

Based on the representation of the Second Party, MIPL has evinced interest in providing training to certain of its students and the Second Party has agreed to avail training from MIPL to certain of its students, on mutually agreed terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Objective

- (a) The Parties agree that this MOU is signed with the objective of furthering industry-academic relationship for mutual benefit, and as part of its activities to build fruitful & mutual relations.
- (b) The main objective of the Program is to enhance the students' skill in technical / general / managerial competencies and mould them suitable to industry needs and current trends.

2. Scope

- (a) MIPL has launched training program exclusively for Engineering / MBA students and it will be imparting professional training to the specified number of students of the Second Party. The duration of the training will be mutually agreeable days. The training program will be conducted either in the Aalim Muhammed Salegh College Of Engineering situated at Muthapudupet, Avadi, IAF, Chennai 600055 or at Michelin factory situated at A-1 SIPCOT Industrial Complex, Thervoykandigai, Thiruvallur District, Tamil Nadu ("MIPL Site") or any other place mutually agreed depending of the nature of the program
- (b) The Second Party understands, that the Program is participatory in nature and does not guarantee any future placement opportunities for the students being selected for the program either at MIPL or any other organization. It shall be the responsibility of the Second Party to ensure that the students are made aware about the objectives and nature of the Program and MIPL will also inform students during awareness program and prior to commencement of training

3. **Consideration**

- (a) The consideration for the training program and training module will be mutually discussed and agreed by the representatives of MIPL and the Second Party prior to the commencement of training in writing;
- (b) Second Party shall remit the training fee of the training program on behalf of participating students while collecting the certificate from MIPL.
- (c) Second party shall take care of the transportation of their students and shall pay for the food arrangements for their students which will be included in the training fee

Obligations of MIPL

- (a) MIPL shall provide to the students, the Personal Protective Equipment needed to undergo the training in respective MIPL labs; and
- (b) On the completion of the Program, MIPL shall provide the certificate for the students who have completed the Program successfully.

Obligations of the Second Party

- (a) Second Party will provide the required training hall, projector and other necessary equipment and tools as may be necessary to conduct trainings at college premises. Second Party shall ensure that such premises and assets are duly covered under appropriate insurance policy;
- (b) Second Party will ensure the punctuality and attendance of the students registered for training in MIPL Site

4. **Term**

This MOU will come into effect on the 12th October, 2017 and will expire on 11th October 2020 and may be renewed by the Parties as may be mutually agreed in writing.

5. **Records**

Second Party shall maintain an accurate and complete record in respect of the training provided by MIPL under this MOU.

6. **General Provisions:**

- a) This MOU, shall form the entire agreement between Second Party and MIPL superseding the contents of any other negotiations, whether oral or in writing, pertaining to the subject of this MOU.
- b) The rights and obligations of Second Party are limited to the terms and conditions of this MOU. Accordingly, Second Party and its personnel involved in activities hereunder on its behalf shall not be entitled to any benefit, payment, compensation or entitlement.
- c) Second Party shall cover its students under appropriate insurance policy against all risks associated with the training on or off the college premises (including MIPL premises) and shall take full responsibility with respects to its students for any eventualities thereof.

- d) Second Party shall be solely liable for claims by third parties (including its students) arising from Second Party's acts or omissions in the course of performing this MOU and under no circumstances shall MIPL be held liable for such claims by third parties.
- e) In the event of any breach of the terms hereof, Second Party shall indemnify MIPL as required.
- f) Second Party undertakes to comply with the MIPL Code of Ethics which is available in the website <http://www.michelin.com/eng/michelin-group/profile/our-ethics> and to enforce the enshrined ethics therein and in their relationship with any statutory authority and in dealings with all concerned individuals. MIPL shall monitor and ensure compliance with said Code of Ethics and the same shall be subject to review by MIPL from time to time. Second Party agrees to indemnify MIPL for all cost, loss and damage (including agreed professional fees) caused to MIPL due to the non-compliance of the Code of Ethics Second Party, its personnel, consultants, associates and affiliates.
- g) Either party terminate this MOU at any time by giving thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.
- h) In case of any dispute or interpretation issue relating this MOU, the party which raises the dispute shall inform the other party in writing and within 7 days of such notification the parties shall mediate and try to find a solution amicably failing which, the same may be referred to arbitration by a sole arbitrator appointed mutually by both the parties in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The arbitration shall be governed by the laws of India. The place of Arbitration shall be at Chennai and the language of arbitration shall be in English.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Grant

- 1.1. The Grantor hereby grants the license to permit. Reference Jio Infocomm Limited ("Jio") and Jio agrees to use the right to:
 - i. Deploy, lay, fit, install, set up, establish, operate, maintain and or otherwise use ("Commissioning or Commissioned") any or all of its materials, fixtures, fittings and equipment(s) ("Infrastructure"), required to establish and provide any or all of the various services by Jio, including wireline and wireless telecommunication services (the Services), from and out of and within the Grantor's Premises (the Premises) to its subscribers, subject to tariff & other terms & conditions determined by Jio, from time to time. A schedule comprising the details of the space licensed for use by Jio in the Premises, together with the list of the Infrastructure Commissioned by Jio therein will be documented & signed by the Grantor and Jio after completion of the Commissioning.
 - ii. Access to all parts of the Premises, including, facilities, existing ducts, pathways, raceways, shafts, entrance link, rooftop and building wiring ducts, cable trays, basements, terraces, etc., common areas for the purpose of Commissioning and maintenance of the Infrastructure on 24x7x365 basis.
 - iii. Conduct promotional activities such as setting up Hoop / helpdesk(s), organizing awareness camps / roadshows for the occupants within the Premises, on need basis.

2. Rights of Jio

- 2.1 To use the Premises by itself and/or through its Affiliates, which, directly or indirectly, controls or is controlled or under the common control of Jio / Affiliates.
- 2.2 To restrict or suspend access to its Services in order to carry out testing, technical repair, maintenance, upgrade, or for any other reason at Jio's sole discretion.
- 2.3 Allow access to Services only based on processes defined by Jio, subject to terms and conditions of such Services, tariffs, as per applicable Government regulations, guidelines, directions, rules and conditions of the Unified License issued by DoT, TRAI and shall have the right to restrict any unauthorized usage.
- 2.4 To retain ownership and control of all Digital spaces, except of, but not limited to Landing Page(s), Login Flow Page(s) and Jio's website(s), Customer Details and usage information.
- 2.5 To be the exclusive provider of its Services through its Infrastructure from the Premises, unless otherwise agreed.
- 2.6 To enjoy the benefits of the license to use the Premises per terms and conditions agreed herein, as long as the license is valid, unless Jio surrenders the license after providing minimum thirty (30) days prior information in writing to the Grantor, or otherwise mutually agreed.
- 2.7 To assign or transfer the rights and obligations under this Agreement in favor of any person or entity.

3. Obligations of Grantor

- 3.1 To provide Jio with the space identified and earmarked in the Premises for use by Jio (Secure, uninterrupted, ventilated and noise-free) for the Commissioning and maintenance of the Infrastructure, including grant of right of way.
- 3.2 To ensure due and sufficient diligence for the safety and security of the Infrastructure within the Premises.
- 3.3 To provide uninterrupted power supply with required back up to Jio for maintaining and operating its WiFi & Small Cell services, without any charges.
- 3.4 Grantor by itself or through its Authorized Person will be responsible for any or all consents and permissions, if any required from any third parties, for and in relation to the grant of the license.

4. Ownership of Infrastructure

- 4.1 The Infrastructure, as Commissioned, shall always remain the absolute property of Jio. Jio alone shall have the right to modify, replace, upgrade, remove, operate and maintain the same.
- 4.2 In case of insurance claims, by Jio, due to theft or damage to any part of the Infrastructure, the Grantor will assist Jio in every possible manner with respect to the same.
- 4.3 Jio shall not be responsible for any damages caused to the Premises or any bodily injury / death caused to any person in any manner, due to the Infrastructure Commissioned in the Premises, for reasons not attributable to Jio.

5. General

- 5.1 Apart from the Grantor's agreement to grant license and Jio's agreement to use the Premises, unless otherwise agreed, the Grantor and Jio expressly confirms that there will be no monetary consideration, payable from and/or to each other.
- 5.2 Jio assures that:
 - i. It shall build, own, operate, and manage the Infrastructure in the Premises including maintenance and repair. It shall take reasonable care to ensure that the Commissioning process is carried out with minimal intrusion and that the normal functioning of the Premises is not disturbed.
 - ii. All Commissioning pertaining to the Infrastructure shall be at Jio's own cost.
- 5.3 Any request for relocation of the deployed Infrastructure shall be considered on case to case basis subject to technical feasibility and without affecting the quality of services and on approval from Jio's team.
- 5.4 Grantor represents that its obligations will devolve on its successors and assigns.
- 5.5 In no event will Jio be liable for any special, incidental, indirect or consequential damages, losses or claims of any nature whatsoever, whether in tort, contract or otherwise including loss of profit.
- 5.6 Jio shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Grantor against any actions, claims, proceedings, losses, which the Grantor may suffer due to any act or omission of Jio in complying with rules and regulations of the Municipal/local authorities in connection with the installation of its Infrastructure in the Premises.
- 5.7 The Grantor shall indemnify and keep indemnified Jio against any actions, claims, proceedings, losses, which Jio may suffer (i) due to any act or omission of the Grantor in complying with the rules and regulations of Municipal/local authorities, non-payment of any taxes, levies, etc. with respect to the Premises (ii) on account of any defect in title of the Grantor with respect to the Premises (iii) any liability for any commitment made by the Grantor to a Jio Customer(s) (iv) any tax, interest, penalty claims, etc. due to non-deductibility/non-deduction of tax at source by Jio from an amount paid / credited to the Grantor, and (v) any claims from third parties, if any, under this Agreement.
- 5.8 Any dispute of any nature arising out of, or in relation to, the terms and conditions of this license shall be settled through arbitration in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The seat of arbitration will be Mumbai and the award passed by the arbitrator(s) will be binding on all parties to this document.
- 5.9 The Parties and this agreement shall be governed by the laws of India, and shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of courts in the city of Mumbai (India) alone.
- 5.10 These Terms and conditions, details of Infrastructure installed are and shall always form an integral part of the Form.

AND

AALIM MUHAMMED SALEGH TRUST a society/trust duly registered under the laws of India, having its place of business at "Nizara Bonanza", 813, Anna Salai (Opp LIC), Chennai 600002 and which runs Aalim Muhammed Salegh College Of Engineering represented by Mr. Segu Jamaludeen (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party" which expression, unless repugnant to the context, shall mean and include its authorized and legal representatives, employees, successors-in-interest and permitted assigns) of the OTHER PART (AMS).

Any Statement of Work entered into, shall set out the details, terms and conditions of specific training services to be provided hereunder, in addition to the terms under this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements and covenants hereafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:



1. OBLIGATIONS

- a. For the purposes of this Agreement, Services shall mean the training services that iGrow provides under the Statement of Work (hereinafter referred to as the "Services"). The Services shall be delivered to the AMS, at its premises or any other location agreed upon between the parties under the Statement of Work. iGrow shall provide the Services under this Agreement using its own personnel or external consultants engaged by iGrow for the provision of the Services.
- c. AMS understands that the Program is participatory in nature and does not guarantee any future placement opportunities for the students being selected for the program either at iGrow or any other organization. It shall be the responsibility of the AMS to ensure that the students are made aware about the objectives and nature of the Program and iGrow will also inform students during the awareness program and prior to commencement of training. AMS will provide the required training facility, projector and other necessary equipment's to conduct trainings at college premises and shall ensure that such premises and assets are duly covered under appropriate insurance policy.

2. PAYMENTS

- a. AMS shall pay the Training Provider for the Services, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement and the agreed price as set forth in the relevant Statement of Work. The agreed prices are exclusive of all taxes. Invoices shall be raised on the completion of a Course
- b. AMS shall remit the fee of the training/Project program on behalf of participating students, if applicable, while collecting the certificate from iGrow who have completed program successfully.

3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND CONFIDENTIALITY

- a. AMS acknowledges that all rights, title and interest (including without limitation any and all patent, copyright, trademarks, moral rights, design rights and all other proprietary rights), that is now or may be available, in any of the content or trainings which forms a part of the Services provided under this Agreement, and created or conceived by iGrow, shall vest with iGrow at all times.
- b. The parties shall, upon request or upon the termination or expiry of this Agreement howsoever occurring, promptly return to the disclosing party all materials, writings, equipment, models, mechanisms, and the like obtained from or through the disclosing party, including, but not limited to, all Confidential Information, all of which the receiving party acknowledges is the sole and exclusive property of the disclosing party.



4. TERM & TERMINATION

Arbitration and jurisdiction:

In case of any dispute between the parties in respect to any of the terms in this MoU, the parties undertake to settle the same by issuing a notice within 15 days from the date of the issue becoming known to either party. In case no such settlement is arrived at after mutual negotiations, the matter may be resolved by arbitration and shall be governed by the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 subject to any statutory modification, amendment or re-enactment, from time to time. The seat of arbitration shall be New Delhi. Subject to above, wherever juridical intervention is possible, the Parties agree that courts in New Delhi will have exclusive jurisdiction.

MoU effective date:

Term of MoU:



MISCELLANEOUS


